24 Hours Lisbon Hop-on Hop-off City Tour The trip follows the Tagus from the heart of the city to Parque das Nacoes. Visit the modern and innovative Lisbon.	Daily	Every 30 minutes	€50.00

You will then head onwards as far as Belem. Here, there are graceful views out over the monuments honouring Portugal's golden era of exploration: Padrao dos Descobrimentos, Belem Tower, the Monastery of Jeronimos. Before dining, there is also time for views of the 25 de Abril Bridge and the Cristo Rei statue. Full Day Fatima, Obidos, Nazare, Batalha & Alcobac Enjoy a tour through the area north of Lisbon, going to the World-famous Fatima, Nazare, Obidos and Alcobaca. The tour depart first to encounter Obidos and meet its medieval walls, rustic white houses and the rich and varied local traditions of the town, then leave Obidos for Alcobaca to take in the imposing monastery church (UNESCO world heritage), the first Gothic church to be built in Portugal and home to the tombs of the ill-starred lovers D. Pedro and D. Ines de Castro. The tour then heads onto the picturesque and colourful fishing town of Nazare. The tour then moves onto Batalha to visit the monastery church (also UNESCO world heritage), a Gothic masterpiece with the most finely worked stained-glass windows. Finally, you will reach the Our Lady of Fatima Sanctuary, an altar of the Christian faith and site of world pilgrimage. There is also the Chapel of Apparitions with its portrayal of Our Lady of Fatima. Take the time also for the location of the Basilica with the tombs of the three witnesses, and the Church of the Holy Trinity, the fourth largest in the world by capacity.	Daily 09h00	11 Hours	€85.00
Full Day Lisbon & Sintra, Cascais, Estoril First of all, you will visit the Belem quarter where you will find the most beautiful and historical monuments from the 15th and 16th centuries. A brief stop at the Belem Tower (Torre de Belem) - World Heritage by UNESCO - point of departure of some of the Portuguese maritime explorations; and on the Monument to the Discoveries (Padrao dos Descobrimentos), built to celebrate the 500th anniversary of the "death" of Prince Henry the Navigator. Then visit the Church of S. Jerome Monastery (Mosteiro dos Jeronimos) - World Heritage by UNESCO - a masterpiece of the "Manueline" style. Along the river you will arrive at Alfama, an old and traditional district, where you will have the opportunity to walk in its narrow streets. Then you will pass by the downtown (Baixa) to admire the most important squares of Lisbon such as the monumental Trade Square (Praca do Comercio); Rossio Square, the heart of Lisbon and the symbolic Restauradores Square. Then you will drive along the Liberdade Avenue, the "boulevard" of Lisbon, to finish at Marques de Pombal Square, admiring the statue of the 18th-century Portuguese statesman responsible for Lisbon reconstruction after one of the deadliest earthquakes in History, the 1755 Lisbon Earthquake.
