<p>Sounion Half Day - Athens</p>	<p>Driving along the coastal road past the wonderful beaches of Glyfada, Vouliagmeni, Varkiza and countless caves, one has a splendid view of the Saronic Gulf. Visit the Temple and feel the spirit and divine nature of the Cape at the end of Europe's land. <p>Half Day Athens Sight Seeing Tour (without museum)</p>	<p>This tour includes an overview of the modern city and striking contrasts to the remains of its glorious past. Drive by the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in front of the Parliament House on Constitution square (Syntagma square), the Panathenian Stadium (where the first modern Olympic Games were held in 1896), the Presidential Palace (ex Royal Palace) government buildings and elegant homes. Drive along Panepistimiou Avenue and view the Catholic Cathedral, the Academy University, National Library and Omonoia square. In contrast, visit to the Roman temple of Olympian Zeus and Acropolis(including Parthenon, the Propylaea, the temple of Athena Nike and the Erechtheion with its Porch of Maidens. 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<p>Ancient Corinth</p>	<p>Starting from Athens we drive westwards along the scenic coast, until we reach the Corinth Canal (short stop). Shortly thereafter we reach the ancient town of Corinth (visit) where St. Paul lived and preached for two years. Back in the ancient times Corinth was amongst the richest cities and this is quite evident by its remains, including the huge agora (market place) and Apollo's Temple (6th C.B.C.) brief stop at the site of the ancient port of Kechreai where St. Paul disembarked. <p>Athens By Night</p>	<p>Your evening dinner /tour begins with a pleasant scenic drive through the illuminated boulevards of Athens, as far as Piraeus, Greece's principal commercial port. Continue to Marina Zea, one of the busiest yacht harbours in the Mediterranean and home port to many luxury pleasure yachts belonging to Greece's ship owners and international jet set communities. From here, short drive to Mikrolimano, another picturesque yacht and fishing boat harbour, home to ex Royal Yacht Club and many fine waterfront seafood restaurants. We finally return to Athens and the renowned "Plaka" district, located around the base of Acropolis, for dinner with live floor show at a typical Greek taverna. 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<p>Full Day Delphi</p>	<p>Drive through the fertile plain of Boeotia, past the towns of Thebes - connected with the tragedy of King Oedipus - Levadia and Arachova, famous for its colourful rugs and carpets (short stop). Arrive at Delphi, the centre of the ancient world - the "Omphalos" (Navel) of the Earth - whose prestige extended far beyond the boundaries of the Hellenic world. On the slopes of Mount Parnassus, in a landscape of unparalleled beauty and majesty, lie the ruins of the Sanctuary of Apollo Pythios. Visit the treasury of the Athenians, the temple of Apollo and the Museum containing such masterpieces of ancient Greek sculpture as the bronze Charioteer and the famous athlete Aghias. <p>One Day Three Island Cruise</p>	<p>Transfer by motor coach to Flisvos marina and embark on the cruise ship. At 08h30 sail for the island of Hydra. In Hydra you are at leisure to stroll, shop or swim. In the early afternoon sail for the island of Aegina, passing through the narrow strait separating the Peloponnesian coast from the island of Poros. Upon arrival in Aegina you can either join the excursion to the Temple of Aphaia (extra cost) or walk around the main town. Lunch is served on board. Sailing for Poros and a short visit of this island. Finally, embark for the sail back to Flisvos marina. 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Argolis Full Day Tour	<p>Leave Athens on the coastal road along the Saronic Gulf to the Corinth canal, which connects the Aegean Sea with the Ionian Sea. After a short stop, drive on to Corinth, the ancient cosmopolitan city, where Saint Paul first brought the message of the Christian faith. Proceed to Mycenae, the Homeric city of the Atreidae - the city "rich in gold" of the ancient poets (visit the Lion Gate, the Cyclopean walls, the Royal tomb, etc). Depart for Nafplion through the fertile plain of Argolis, the picturesque town nestling at the foot of a cliff crowned by the mighty ramparts of the Palamidi fortress. Proceed on to Epidaurus to visit the Theatre (4th century B.C.) famous for its astonishing acoustics.
