<p><b>A Tale of Two Cities</b></p>	<p>A Tale of Two Cities - Sharjah/ Ajman This fascinating tour takes you to the two emirates of Sharjah and Ajman.</p> <p>Ajman's enchanting museum, housed in an ancient fort, earlier the residence of the ruler of Sharjah, will give you intriguing insights into lifestyles prior to the discovery of oil. We pass the King Faisal Mosque and Al Ittihad Monument, both built to honour the memory of King Faisal of Saudi Arabia, who was responsible for subsidising the development of Sharjah.</p> <p>While returning we will stop at the creek for an opportunity to photograph colourful dhows and visit the 165 year-old Al Naboodah House, which vividly recalls the way of life of a wealthy pearl trading family. We will walk through the Al Arsah Souk, one of the few remaining traditional market places and the Blue Souk, where more than 600 shops sell carpets, gold, silver, antiques and perfumes.</p> <p>We return to Dubai in time for lunch.</p> <p><i>This is a morning tour that departs every Sundays and Thursdays. The contrast between the ancient Bedu lifestyle and one of the world's latest sports makes this an unforgettable tour.</p> <p>Leaving Dubai at 08h00 your four-wheel drive vehicle takes you far into the desert, where you meet your camel caravan for a half-hour ride across the spectacular red dunes of Murgham. Here you abandon tradition for one of the world's newest and most exciting sports - sand skiing. <p><b>City of Merchants – Dubai City Tour</b></p>	<p>A fascinating historical excursion. Our route takes us from Burj Al Arab; Dubai's landmark hotel to the Majlis Al Ghorfat, a magnificent structure constructed in 1955 and recently restored, originally the summer residence of the late Sheikh Rashid bin Saeed Al-Maktoum.</p> <p>Driving past modern palaces we stop at Jumeirah Mosque for a photo opportunity. Next our route takes us towards Dubai's Bastakiya area to admire the old-wind-towered houses which were built by wealthy merchants, passing the magnificent Zabeel Palace on the way.</p> <p>Close by stands Al Fahidi Fort, a 200 year-old structure that houses the Dubai Museum and records the city's past as an important pearl diving and trading centre. We continue the journey on a traditional Abra. <p><b>Dubai Walking Tour</b></p>	<p>A walking tour of Dubai's old quarter is the best way to get acquainted with the city's heritage. We begin our trip in Shindagha, with a visit to Sheikh Saeed House - the residence of Sheikh Saeed Al Maktoum, which dates back to 1896 and houses a rare collection of memorabilia and documents which record Dubai's history.</p> <p>Leaving here, we stop at the House of Camels and the Traditional House before heading towards Dubai's Creek. A short walk from the Creek brings us to the textile market, Hindu temple and old souk area. Established at the end of the 19th century by Arab textile and pearl trading immigrants from Bastak in Iran, the winding streets in this locality are lined with restored merchant houses, cafes, boutique hotels and art galleries, the oldest of which is the Majlis Gallery, dating back to the 1970s.</p> <p>We walk through the Bastakiya area and stop at a local house for a quick break giving us an opportunity to sample Arabian hospitality and a taste of traditional Gahwah. We then make our way to the Creek and board a traditional abra (water taxi). Crossing the Creek, we continue our walk through the fragrant alleys of the spice souk on the Deira side of its waters. We move on to Dubai's famous Gold Souk which flaunts dazzling displays of jewellery.
