	JURONG BIRD PARK TOUR	
Jurong Bird Park - Half Day	<p>This tour is a must for bird enthusiasts and a pleasure for those who simply enjoy nature in all its beauty. Our route takes us along Keppel Harbour, part of the world's second busiest port and the Jurong industrial Estate, Singapore's economic showpiece. At the Bird Park, you'll find hundreds of exotic birds. In fact, there are over 7000 birds of more than 600 species gathered in its beautiful 20-hectare sanctuary. Visit the world's largest walk-in aviary and view what is said to be the world's highest man-made waterfall. Also included is an entertaining 25 minutes Bird Show. On the return journey, we visit a light industrial factory. The Ming Village produces replicas of porcelain from the Sung, Yuan, Ming & Qin dynasties.</p>	47.50
	SENTOSA ISLAND MORNING TOUR	
Sentosa Island Morning Tour	<p>Take our coach to Sentosa Island via a bridge and transfer to a monorail to experience an excellent introduction to this tourist and recreational island theme park. Visit Sentosa Underwater World, Asia's largest oceanarium. Next board a bus to Butterfly Park, a beautiful landscape park specially designed to exhibit live butterflies and insects in a lush natural environment. We then take a short walk to the images of Singapore including the World War 2 Surrender Chamber and Pioneers of Singapore. The tour ends with a cable ride, back to the mainland at Mount Faber offering a breathtaking, panoramic view of the port of Singapore.</p>	81.25

Attractions on the island you will visit include the Underwater World, Asia's largest oceanarium, Sentosa Wax Museum to see the pioneers of Singapore and the Surrender Chamber depicting events in Singapore in the 2nd World War. Singapore Night Safari Tour	<p>Welcome to the world of nocturnal creatures and discover the beauty and enchantment of the Animal Kingdom in the world's first Night Safari - this is a new and exciting adventure, which enables you to experience the vastness of a national wildlife park with all the comforts available at a zoo. The 40-hectare park comes alive after dark with some 1,200 animals of 110 species engaging in their fascinating and intriguing nightly rituals. We'll begin with a 45-minutes tram ride to view the sights and hear the sounds. The park is divided into 8 major ecological habitats, each different from the others and each displaying a number of interesting animals. First comes the Himalayan Foothills region with its hardy goat-like tahrs and mouflon sheep. Equatorial Africa offers giraffe, waterbuck and pretty little gazelles.</p>	57.50

Turning back we take a break and stop at the holy island of Kusu (except during the Kusu Festival). This tranquil island is inhabited only by the caretakers of an ancient Chinese Temple. Join us on this unforgettable mini voyage in one of the world's greatest ports.
